Directions to the Institute of Environmental Planning

Public transport

The central station is served by ICE/IC and RE trains from five directions (Dortmund, Bremen, Hamburg, Berlin, Göttingen). You walk through the Passerelle (level -1) or Bahnhofstr. (level 0) to Kröpcke. There you descend to level -3 and take line 4 or 5 in the direction of Garbsen or Stöcken. Get off at the stop "Herrenhäuser Gärten".

Individual means of transport

If you are unfamiliar with the area, driving in from the north is best. Leave the federal highway A2 at the junction Hannover-Herrenhausen in the direction of Hannover (not Neustadt a. Rgbe.!). Take the expressway to the Herrenhausen exit and follow the signs to the university. Immediately after the Großer Garten, a parking lot appears on the right side. Please use this parking lot.

Plane

Arrival is at the airport Hannover-Langenhagen. From there, it is best to take the S-Bahn to the central station. Continue as described above under "Public transport". S-Bahn tickets are also valid on the Stadtbahn.

And then?

We are in the building at Herrenhäuser Str. 2, which is opposite the parking lot. From the stop, you walk back about 100 meters into the city. The buildings are one to two stories high, painted yellow, and slightly set back. There is a larger bicycle parking lot in front of the main entrance. The Institute for Environmental Planning is located in building tract D on the first and upper floor and in building tracts C and E in the attic.
